From Teaching Assistant to Qualified Teacher in two years

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The two-year graduate TA programme supports current TAs (or other school-based staff such as technicians), to train to teach, part-time, whilst retaining a role and salary within school.

The one day of teaching (in Year 1) and two days of teaching (in Year 2) is flexibly divided across the week to best fit the school and current role.

The course fee of £7200 is payable in two equal amounts (one in Year 1 and one in Year 2), and is generally payable by the school and is often negotiated with the school as a salary sacrifice (i.e. deducted from the salary). The salary is negotiable with the school.

Please see the table below for recommended options:

YEAR 1

- 3 days in school as TA
- 1 day of teaching in the current school as a trainee teacher
- 1 day of training with Xavier Teach SouthEast (Thursday for primary, Friday for secondary)

YEAR 2

- 3 days in school as TA
- 2 days of teaching in the current school as a trainee teacher
